5 Tips for Lindy's Sprays

These are the tips I wish I knew when I first picked up a Lindy's spray.

01

Light first, dark on top

Start with your lightest sprays first, then slowly build darker colors on top. It's much easier to deepen a background later than to fix one that became too dark too quickly.

02

Dry between layers

Try not to rush into the next layer while everything is still wet. A quick heat dry keeps the colors cleaner, brighter, and helps prevent muddy backgrounds.

03

Water is your best tool

Mist a little water onto wet spray and just watch what happens. Blooms, soft transitions, texture, movement — this is where Lindy's really starts to shine.

04

Lift color for texture

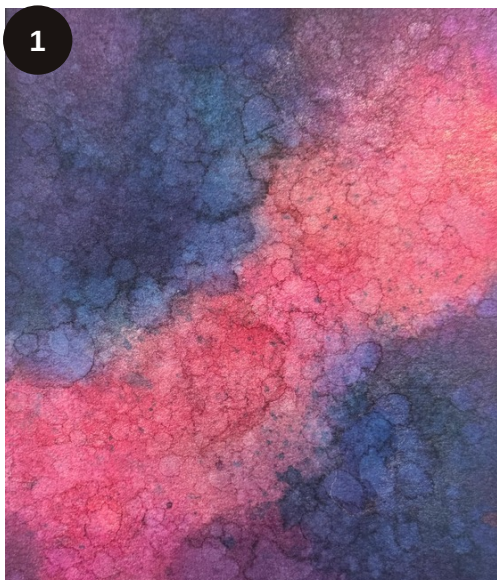
Press a dry or slightly damp wipe onto your wet background and remove some of the color. Some of the best textures happen completely by accident.

05

Missing a color? Use something close

Don't worry if you don't have the exact shade from the list. Just grab the closest color in your collection — Lindy's sprays usually work beautifully together.
